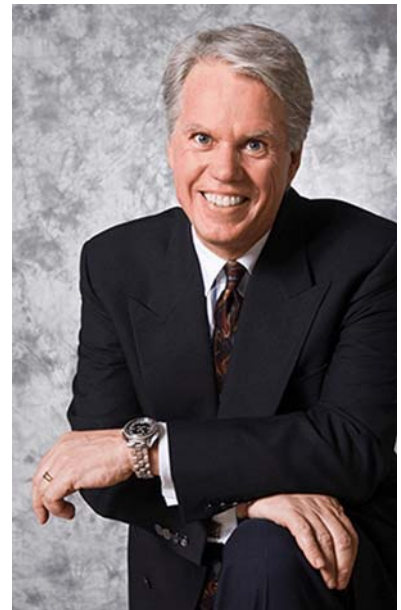


# Neil Dempster
